



Miami Springs Alumni Grant

The Miami Springs Alumni Association Grant is to help defray the cost of the National Convention to needy and worthy students. Based on short essays, math achievement, participation in math activities, practice, and fundraisers, students will be awarded monetary assistance. Students must demonstrate an enthusiasm for math and the ability to write about how the award could help promote their interest in math.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be a member in good standing of the Miami Springs Chapter of Mu Alpha Theta
- Have attended the FAMAT State Convention and at least one overnight.
- Have been a member of a Division team, placed at competition in a "t-score" event, been the top school scorer in a "t-score" event and/or shown significant improvement.
- Have been regular participants in math-club fundraisers.
- Attend a **minimum** of 10 hours of official practice with the team sponsor during June and July. Practice is tentatively scheduled for 5-7 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday nights.

AND

- Complete application form and submit by June 12, 2006.
- Submit three essays, not to exceed 150-words each, answering questions found in the application form.
- Submit a copy of your most recent academic report card/transcript.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of the student's financial need, academic achievement, achievement in math, and the essays which clearly describe why the **math team** needs **you** to attend the Convention.

AWARDS

Partial payment for airfare and/or convention registration..

DEADLINES

Interested students must complete the application and submit it with a current transcript of grades by June 12, 2006. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information.
