Missing/Incomplete items will be penalized at twice the usual rate.

Cover

- FULL Header
- Permanent Writing (no tape, staples, cg etc)

Table of Contents – ALL information filled out

- 4 pages
- Assignments match actual papers
- Footer information is correct

Classroom Notes

- There should be 23-24 pages
- Notes have headers (date and day number) in ink
- Notes show significant work/lesson details
- All notes pages are present
- Cornell format

Journals

- There should be 23-24 pages
- Journals have headers (date and day number) in ink
- Headers can be written on each half page OR both headers can be written at top right
- Journals COMPLETELY fill the page

Homework

- Header should be readable and neat
- Grade should be assigned, there should be a complete list of problems that are completed and there should be a complete list of problems that are incomplete. **WRITE EACH PROBLEM NUMBER**
- Solutions for missing problems should be written in an alternate color.
- Footers should be on the bottom right corner and be consistent with the TOC's (footers should be date that you got the assignment back and the page number in the TOC)
- Name should be written in center line of journals

Tests, Quizzes, Classwork

- Header should be readable and neat
- Footers should be on the bottom right corner and be consistent with the TOC's (footers should be date that you got the test back and the page number in the TOC)

References

- Footers should match entry in TOC (contains date that you got it and the page number of TOC)
